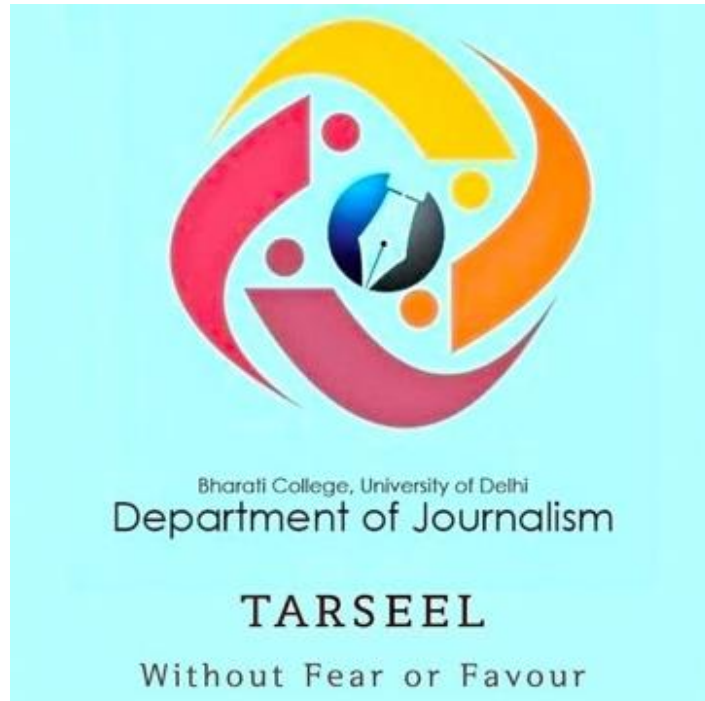

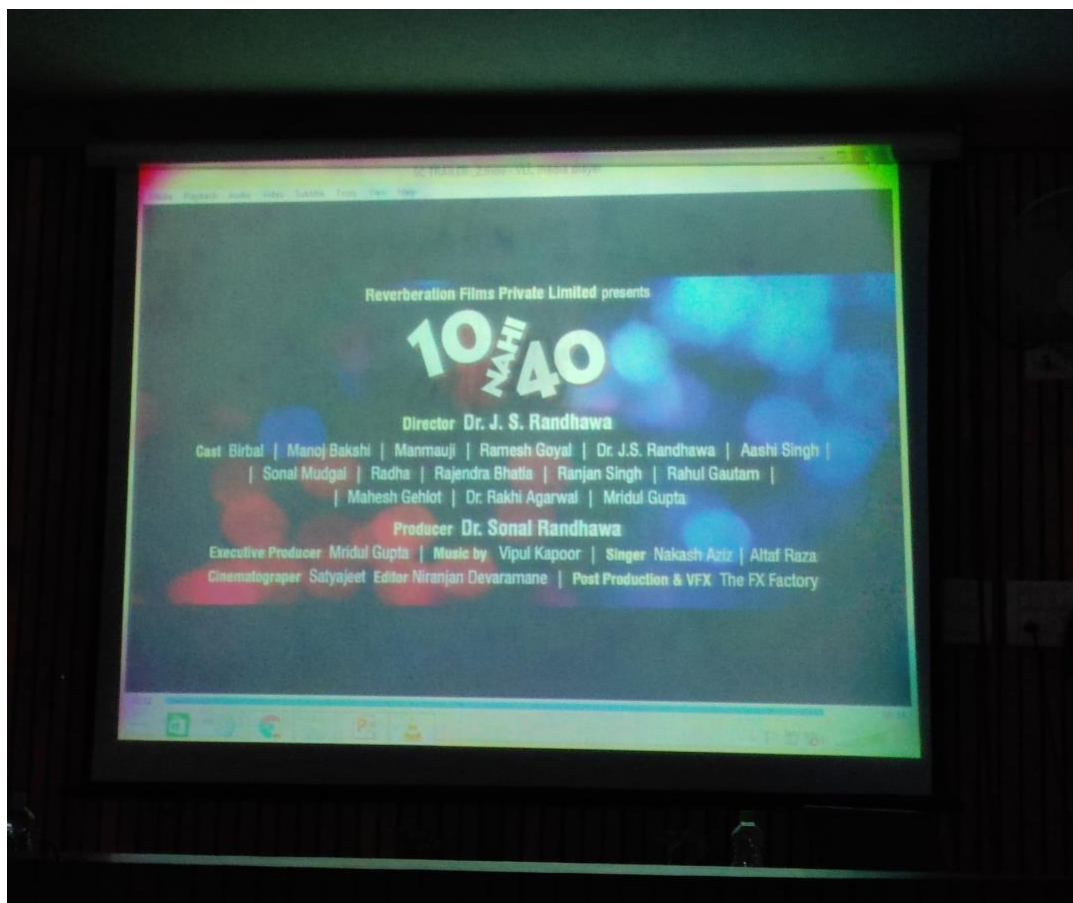

Satinder Kumar Khosla, better known as Birbal, is a Hindi film actor who debuted with Upkar in 1967. Post that he has acted in around 500 movies including Punjabi, Bhojpuri and Marathi language movies.

Made under the direction of Dr J.S. Randhawa, the duo of Manmaujee and Birbal will be seen at their best in the upcoming movie "10 Nahi 40". J. S. Randhawa is an Indian radiologist, filmmaker, actor and producer. He is mainly known for his work in the field of radiology.

The film showcases life through the lens of the elderly, their struggles, their fears and anxieties. It also stresses on the solutions to these insecurities and the role of youngsters in alleviating the same. All in all, it's a movie which makes an attempt to highlight the problems related to senior citizens interlaced with humour to make it entertaining.

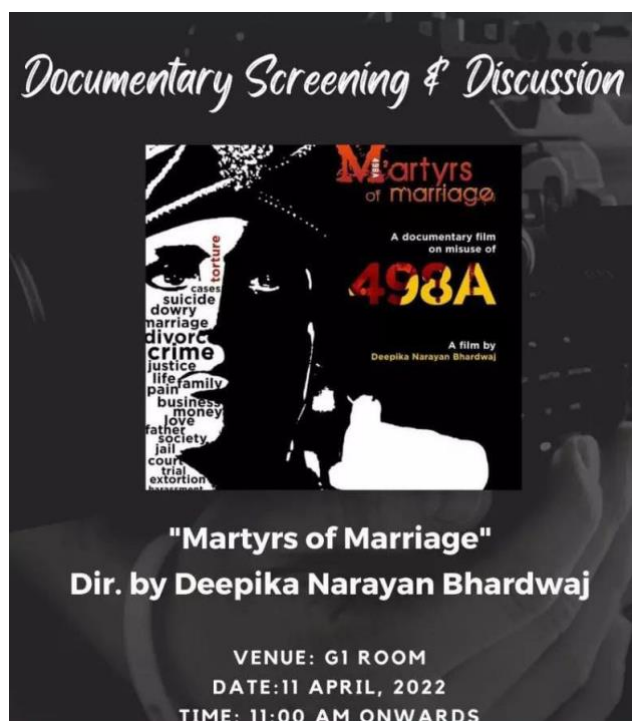

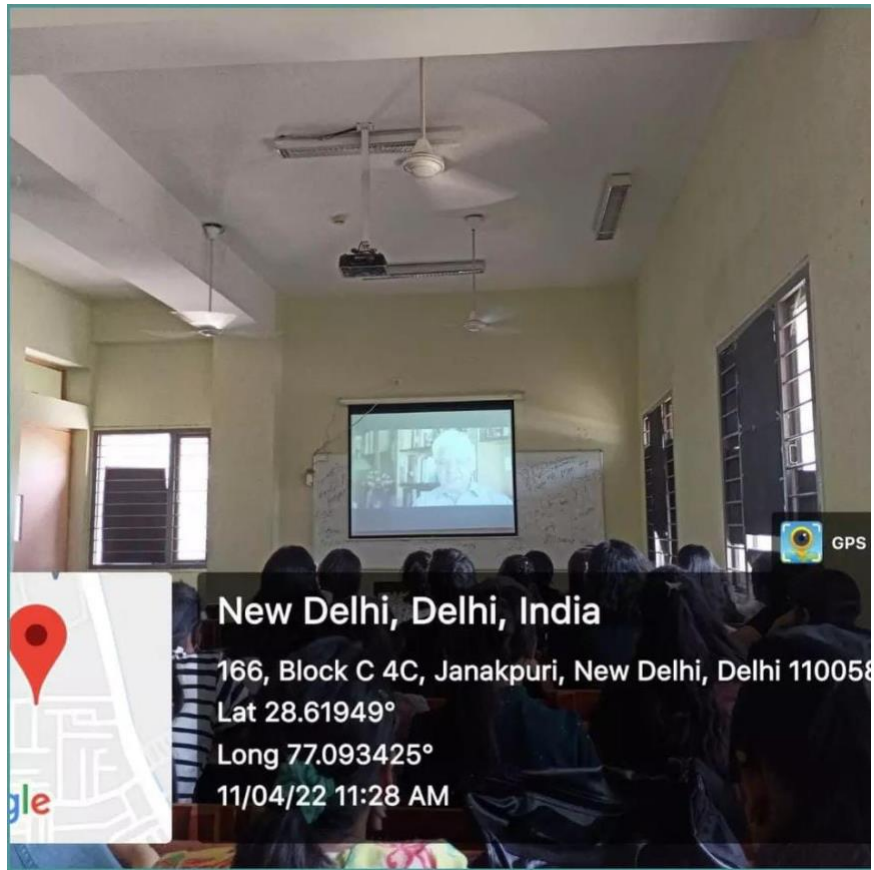

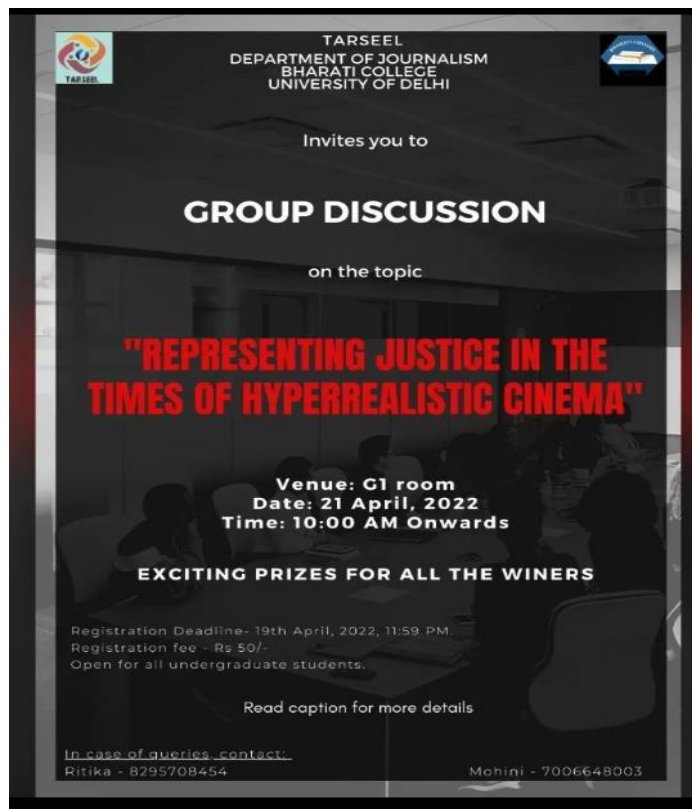

The event was planned and organised by Tarseel - Society of Journalism, keeping in view the changing nature of cinema and its impact on the audience. The hyper-realistic approach has been used in various genres, including drama, science fiction, and war films. It often requires meticulous attention to detail and a high level of technical expertise. The goal is to immerse the audience in the film's world and create a heightened sense of engagement and authenticity.

Participants engaged in lively discussions, exploring how hyperrealistic cinema portrays concepts of justice, fairness, and societal norms. They analyzed various films, dissecting their narratives, characters, and visual representations to understand the evolving dynamics of justice in cinematic storytelling.

The discussion provided valuable insights into the influence of hyperrealistic cinema on shaping perceptions of justice and morality in society. 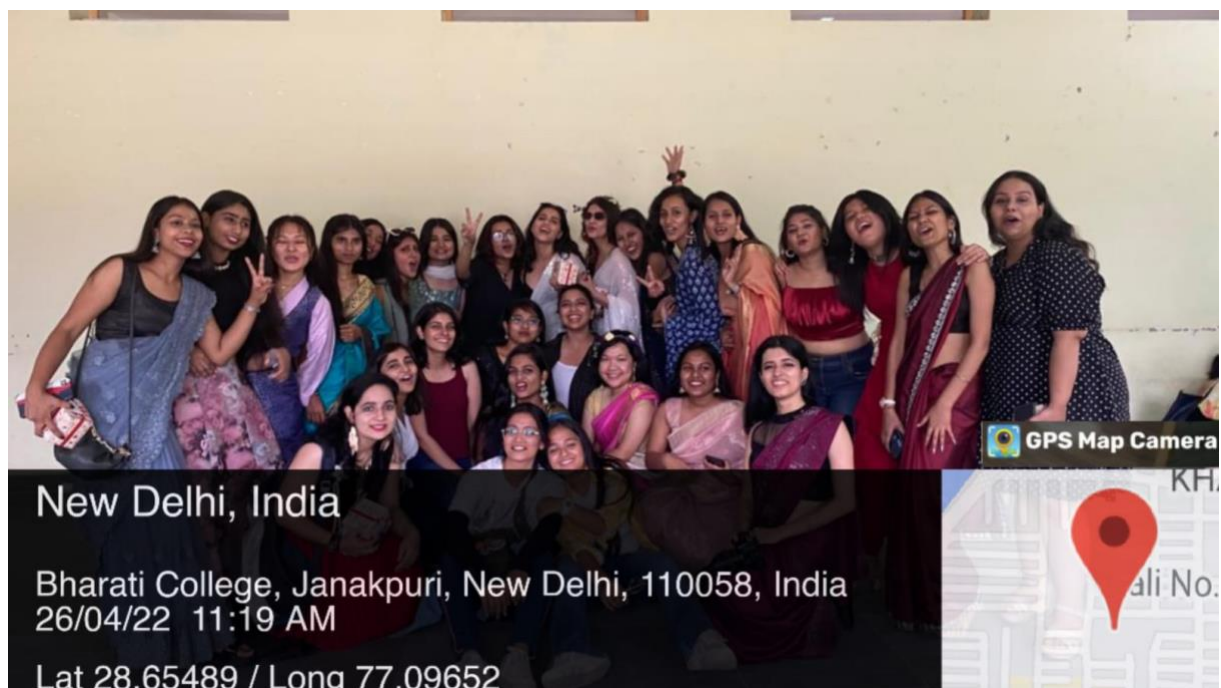

Attendees embraced the glitz and glamour of Bollywood, dressing up as iconic movie characters and enjoying music from popular Hindi films. The atmosphere was filled with

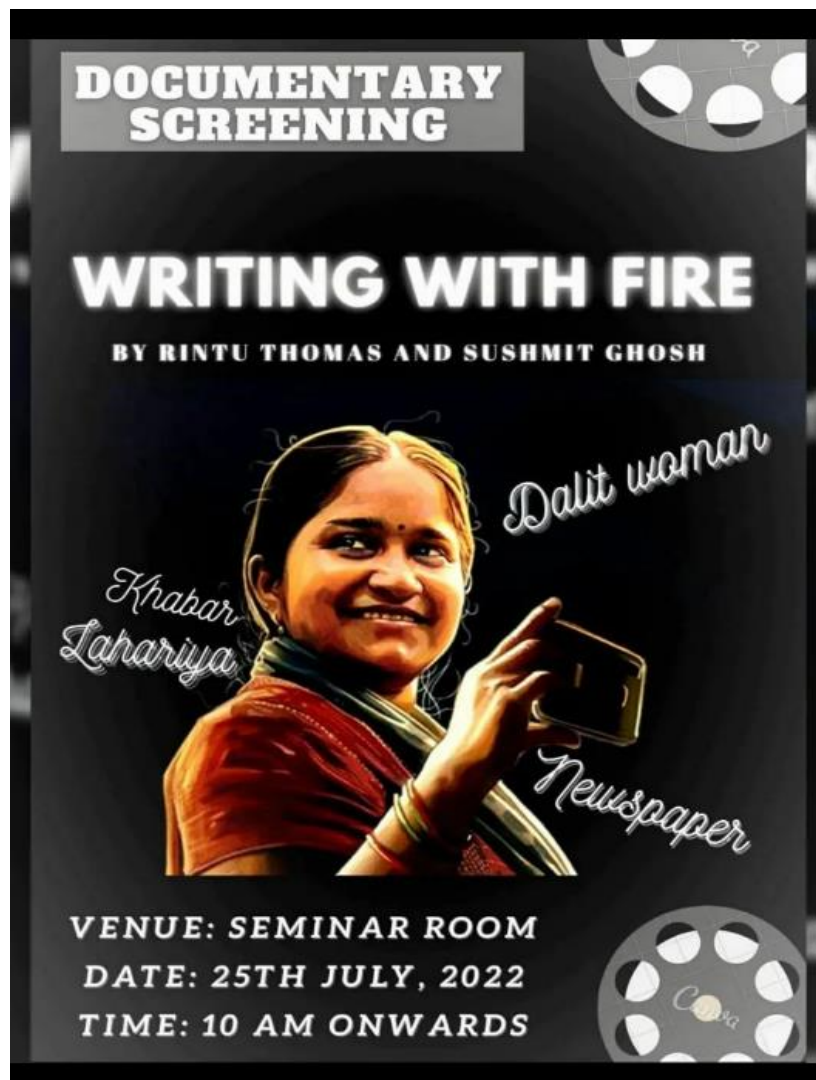

On July 25, 2022, the Department of Journalism held a documentary screening of “Writing with Fire” directed by Rintu Thomas and Sushmit Ghosh. A double Sundance winner, “Writing with Fire” was nominated for an Academy Award for Best Feature Documentary, making it the first Indian feature documentary to be nominated for an Oscar.

Meera Devi, Shyamkali Devi, and Suneeta Prajapati were the women protagonists in the film. In a cluttered news landscape dominated by men, emerged India's only newspaper run by

Dalit women. Armed with smartphones, Chief Reporter Meera and her journalists break traditions, be it on the frontlines of India's biggest issues or within the confines of their homes, redefining what it means to be powerful. The documentary elaborated upon the only newspaper in India that was run by Dalit women - Khabar Lahariya. It inspired every student in the field of Journalism to introspect.
