In the seminar she discuss the barriers which women's face in their career which includes maternal wall, Glass Cliff, pay parity, positioning, challenges at organizational and personal level.



Advertisement is a very important element of marketing , keeping this in mind VANIJYA SAMITI planned to organise one. .




A virtual networking session allowed attendees to connect with each other, fostering collaboration and the exchange of ideas.
