EVENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25

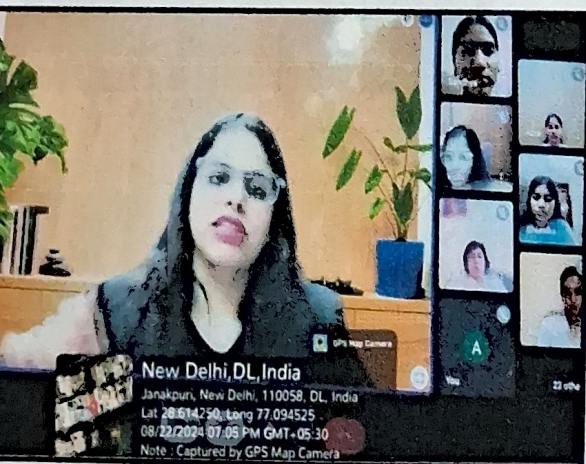
1. Webinar on the Art of Public Speaking

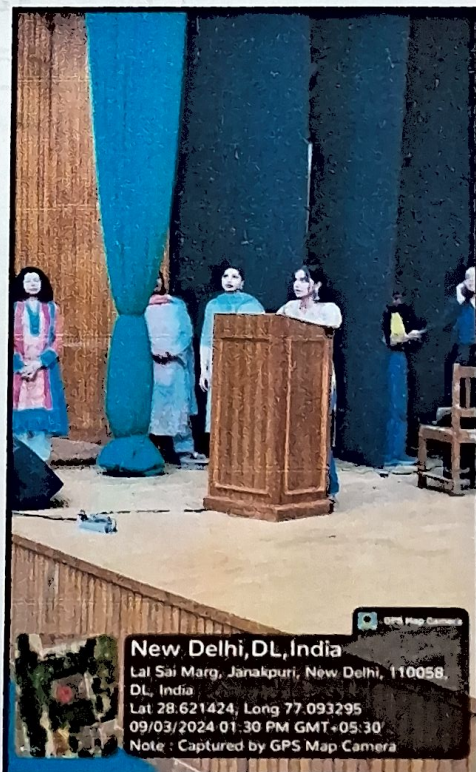
2. Freshers' Cultural Societies Orientation

5. Turncoat Debate and MUN Training Session

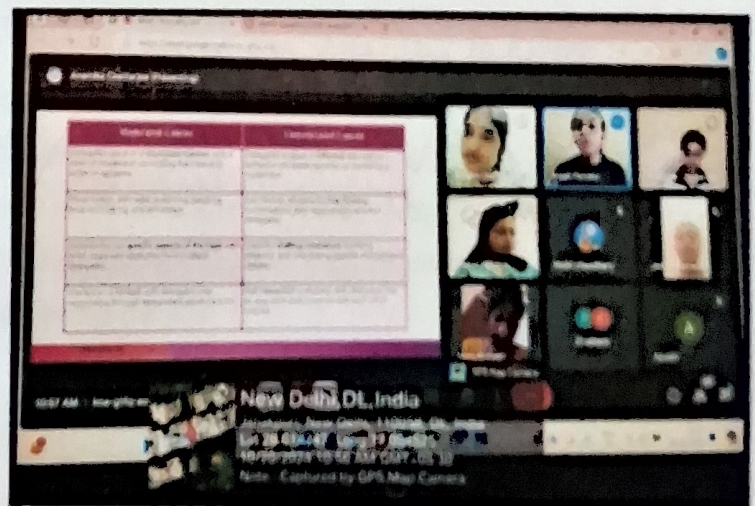
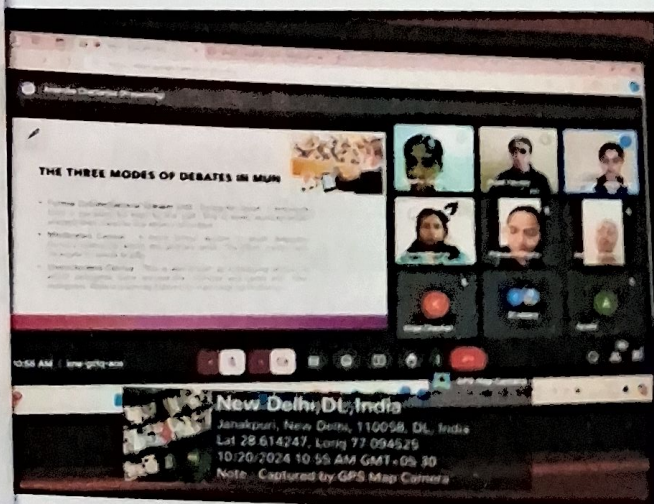

7. Debating skills workshop

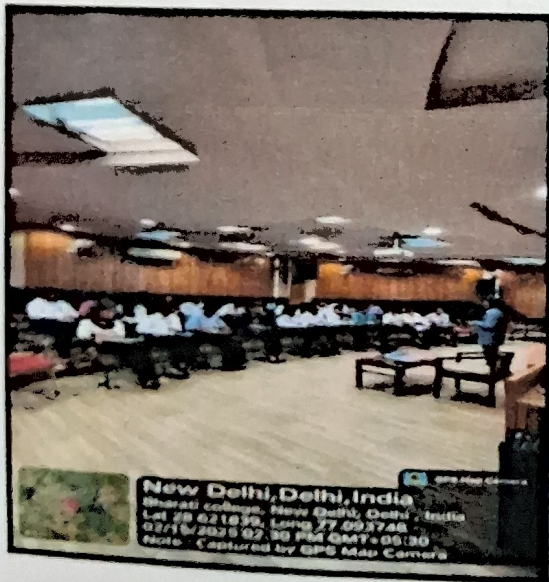

Through a series of interactive activities, the workshop fostered critical thinking, effective argumentation, teamwork, and analytical precision. Participants gained both theoretical insights and practical exposure, reinforcing their understanding of the core principles of competitive debating.

The workshop focused on key elements such as active listening, teamwork in Parliamentary and Lincoln-Douglas formats, and cross-examination techniques. A significant highlight was the Debate Marathon, which encouraged quick thinking and adaptability, followed by a Mock Parliamentary Debate on the topic: *Religious Symbols on Public Buildings*. 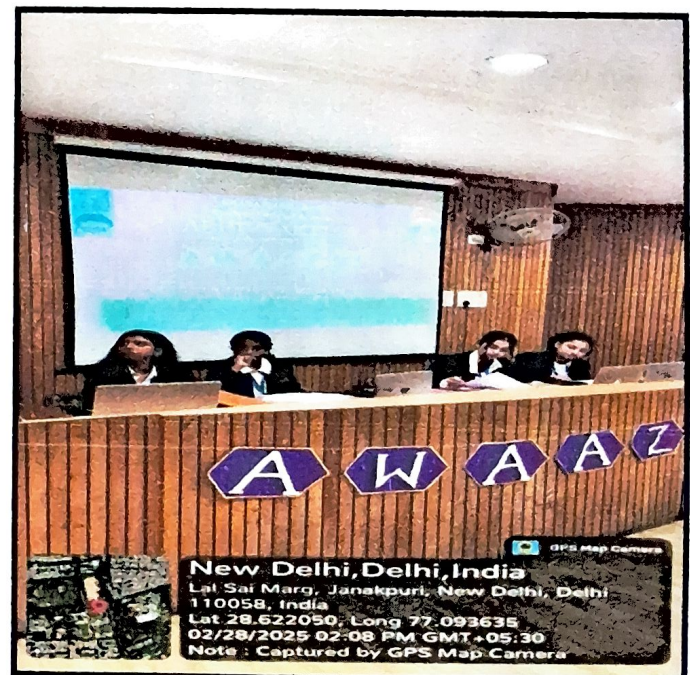

The registration fee of ₹50 per participant was a nominal contribution to the pool of ₹8000 in cash prizes, which were awarded to the winners and runners-up. After a meticulous evaluation by the judging panel, the competition concluded with Devansh Shukla from Rajdhani College securing the first place, while Khanak

Gaur from Indraprastha College for Women emerged as the runner-up. Special Mentions were awarded to Ritesh Dongre from Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College and Abhigya Singh from Jamia Millia Islamia for their commendable performances. 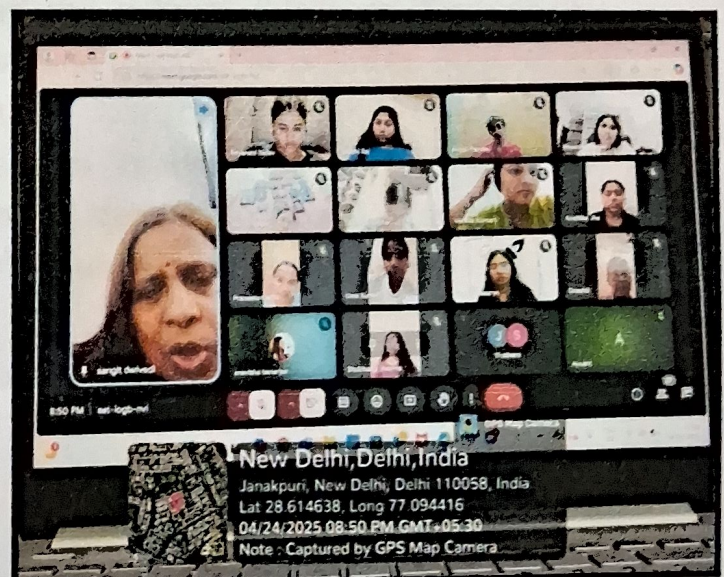
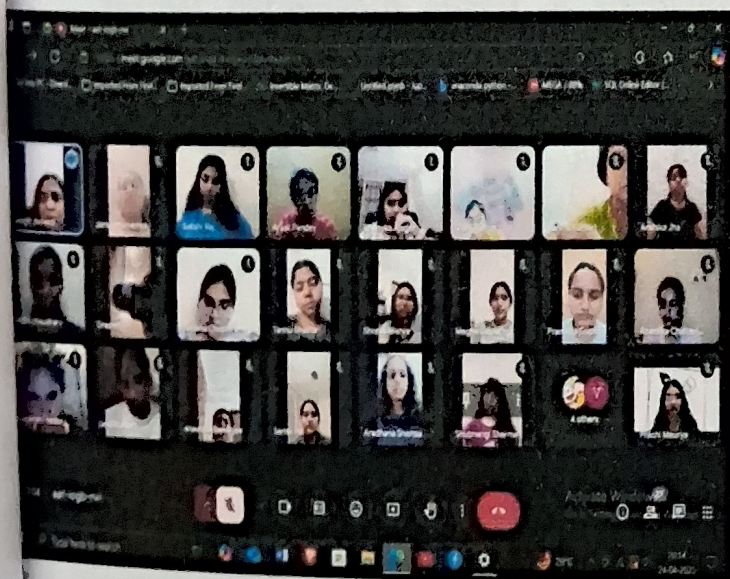
9. Speaker Session

Date: 24th April, 2025

Speaker: Prof. (Dr.) Sangit Sarita Dwivedi, Political Scientist

Chintan- The Debating Society of Bharati College, hosted an insightful session on India's youth-centric demographic and its implications for national development. The session commenced with a thoughtful introduction by Sakshi Raj Wardhan, Public Relations Head, followed by a warm welcome from Dr. Anavisha Banerjee, Convener of Chintan. Prof. (Dr.) Sangit Sarita Dwivedi led the discourse on the topic *Demographic Dividend or Dilemma? The Role of Youth in Viksit Bharat* critically examines whether India's youth demographic, comprising over 65% of the population under 35, represents a demographic dividend or a developmental dilemma. She emphasised the need for strategic policies, inclusive development, and targeted investments to harness the potential of this young workforce.

The speaker further stressed the importance of skill-based education, job creation aligned with youth aspirations, and gender equity as critical factors in realising this demographic potential. Dr. Dwivedi highlighted comparisons with ASEAN and developed nations, pointing to the necessity for timely reforms to prevent issues such as underemployment and brain drain. The session concluded with a stimulating Q&A, followed by appreciative addresses from Dr. Anavisha Banerjee and Chintan's President, Prachi Maurya, who both thanked the speaker for her valuable insights into the role of youth in shaping India's future.

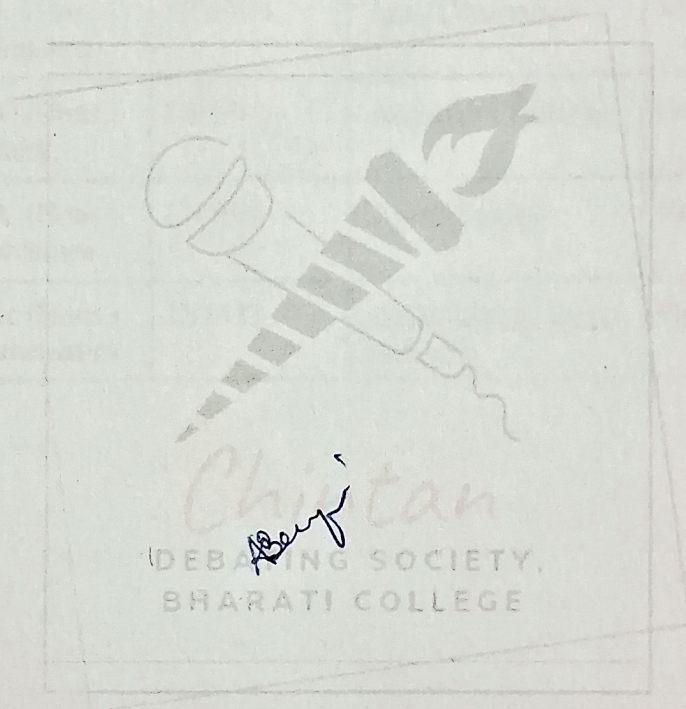
