## 1. ECA Societies Orientation

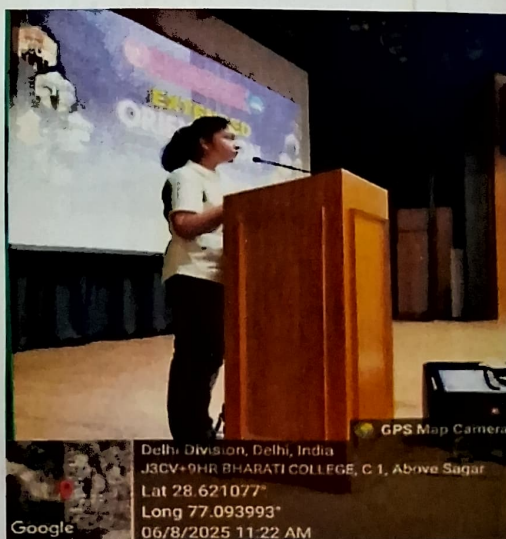
**Date:** 6th August 2025

## 2. Speaker Insights Session

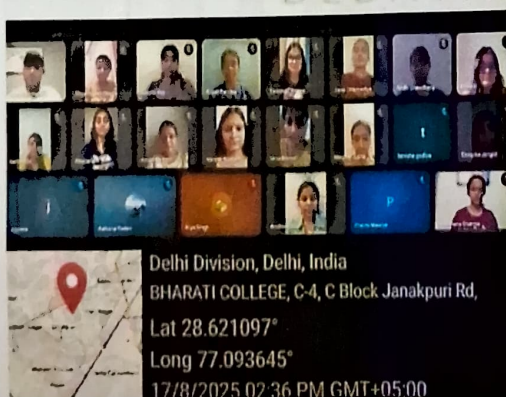
**Date:** 17th August 2025

### 3. Auditions 2025-2026

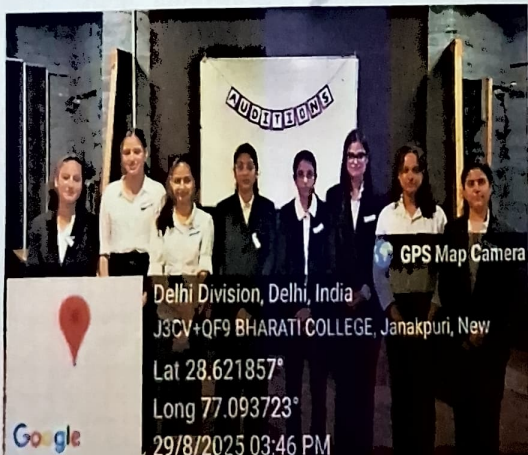
**Date:** 29th August 2025

## 5. Debate Dynamics Workshop

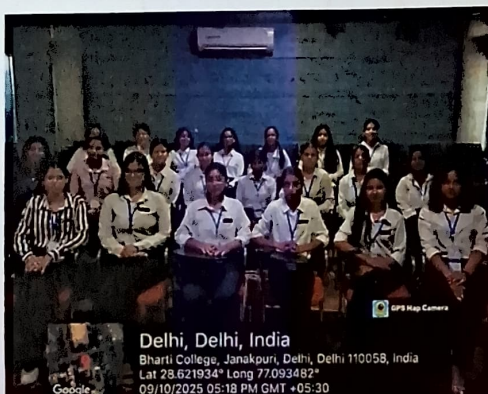
**Date:** 9th October 2025

## 7. Awaaz '26

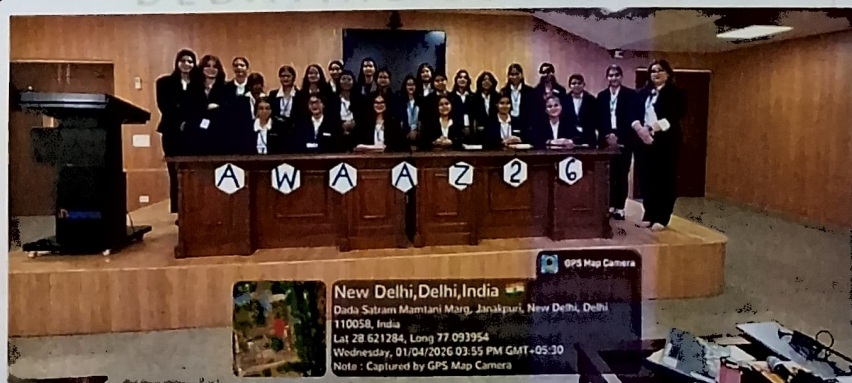
**Date:** 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026

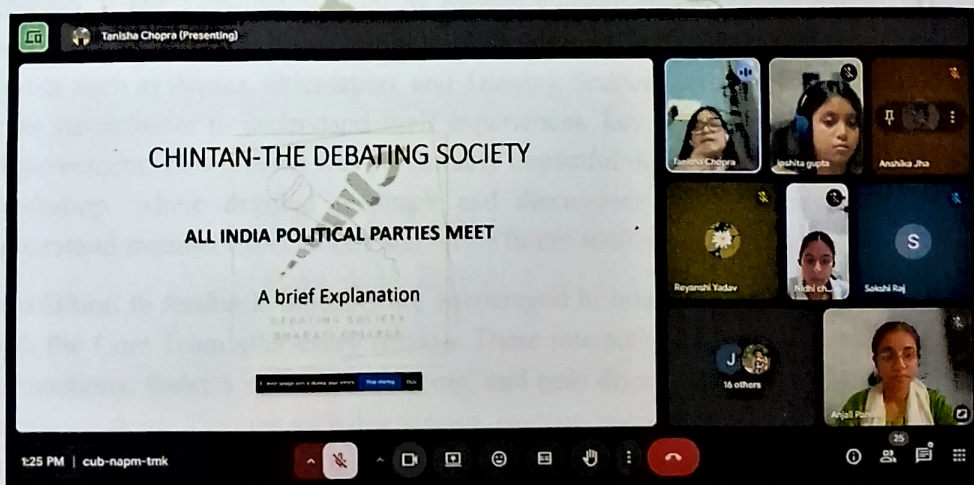

## CHINTAN INITIATIVES

- **Online MUN Training Sessions**



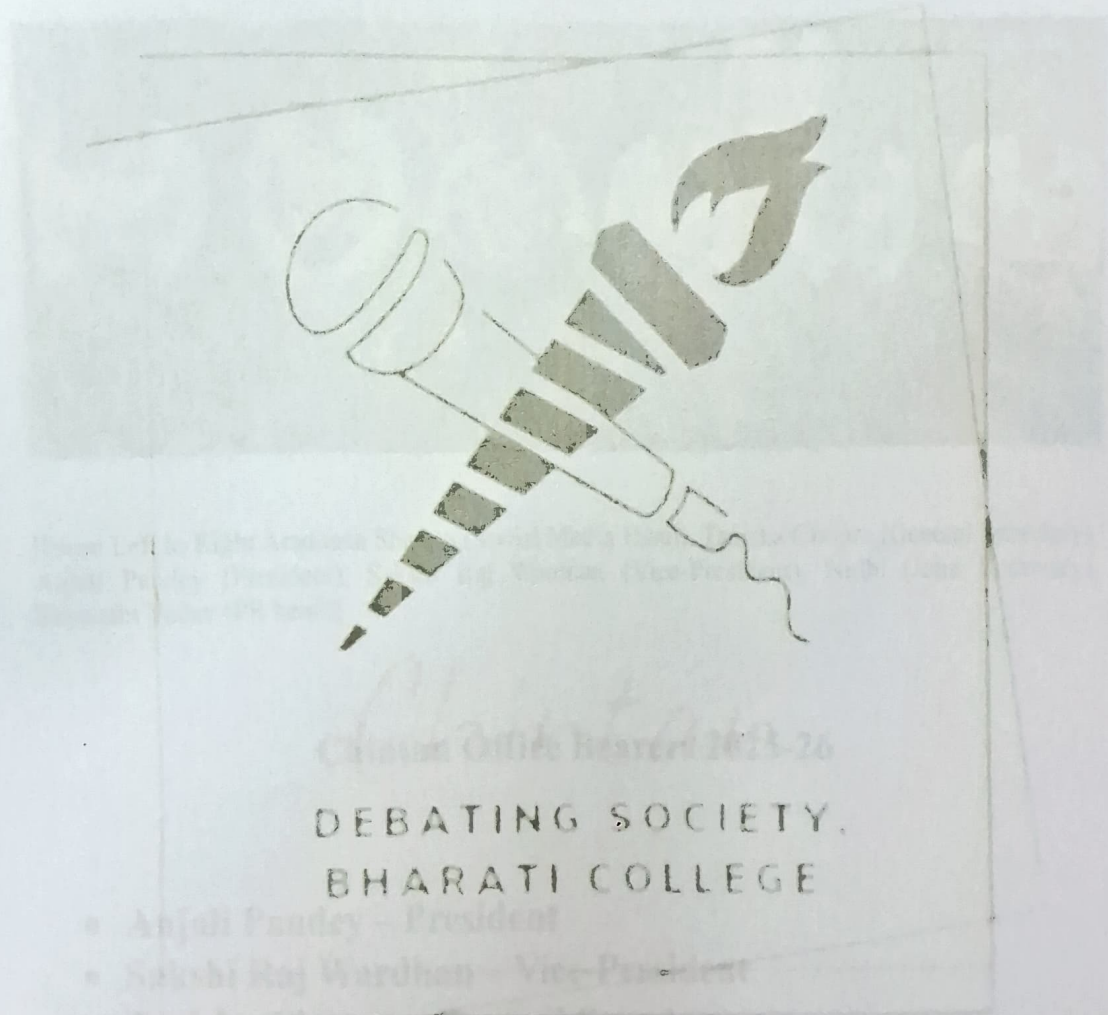
