The event concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to all participants, and attendees who made this poetic gathering an unforgettable celebration of words and wonder.

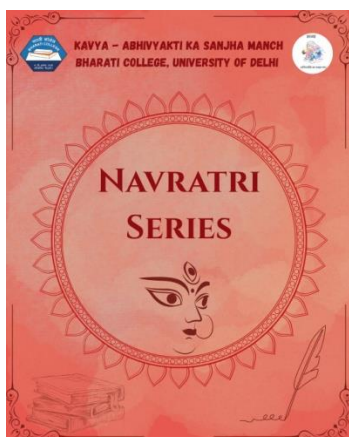


Navratri series

From 22nd September 2025 to 30th September 2025, our Navratri series brought together poetry and devotion, with each day dedicated to a different form of the Goddess on Instagram.

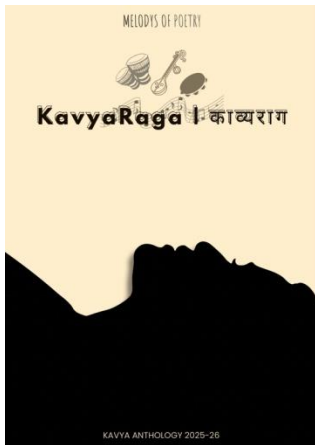
Through the words of various poets, we celebrated the essence of Shakti ,strength, grace, and resilience turning each post into a small tribute of faith and expression.
